Frequently Asked Questions

Prospective students often ask how long the **Bachelor of Science in Nursing** takes to complete, what the program costs and if financial aid is available, and if the degree is awarded through USC Upstate.

You can find answers to these questions below.

- The online RN-BSN program requires that a student have an associate degree or diploma in nursing from an accredited program with 33 nursing credit hours and an active Registered Nurse (RN) License. Admission to the program is offered 5 times throughout the year, and the degree is typically completed in 12 months.
- Students are eligible to receive applicable federal and state financial aid assistance. Current fees and tuition rates can be viewed at www.palmettocollege. sc.edu.
- The BSN program at the Mary Black College of Nursing at USC Upstate, is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) and approved by the South Carolina Board of Nursing.



Prerequisites and Requirements

To apply for this online degree program, students must have:

- General Education Pre-Requisites
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA in all previous college-level coursework
- Associate Degree in Nursing
- Be a Registered Nurse with an unencumbered license

Curriculum

The curriculum includes coursework in the following disciplines:
