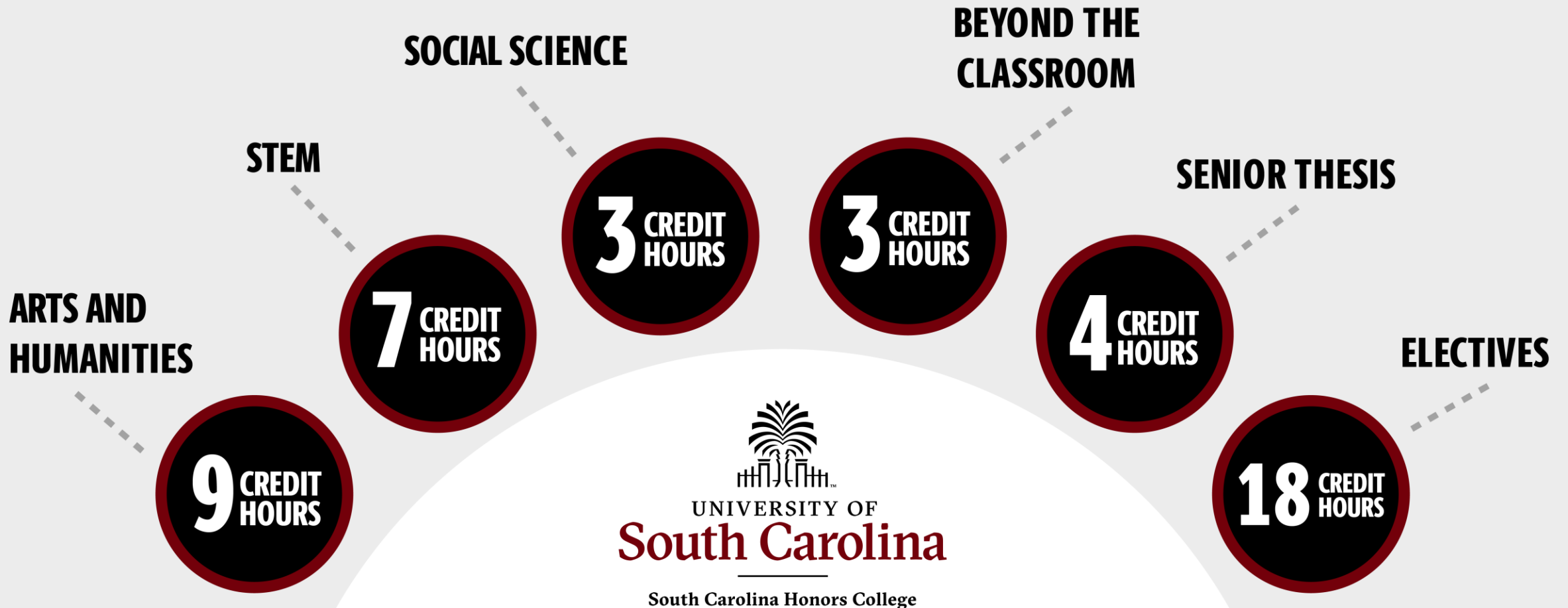


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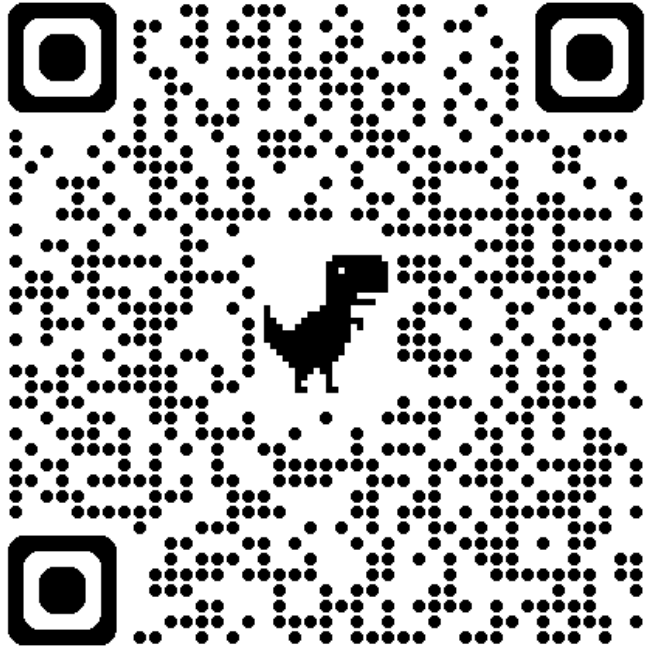

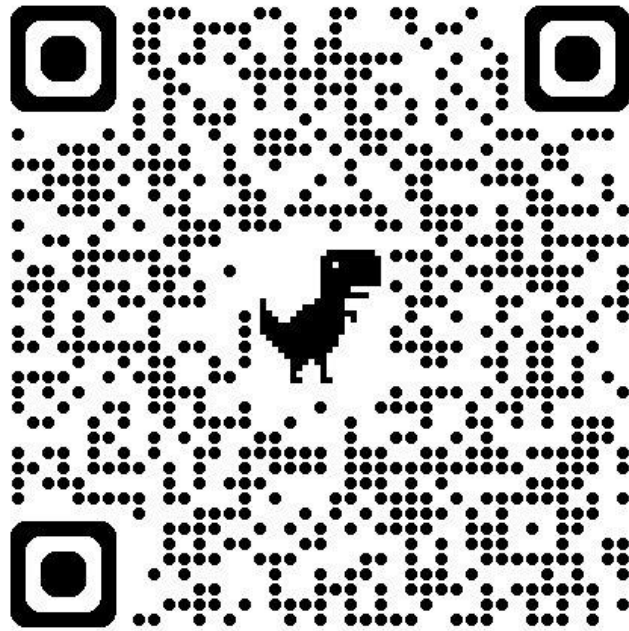
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- Separate SCHC (Honors) Plan will be created for all students continuing in dual advising model
- Plan will include courses advised for Spring 2025 **and** student's thesis timeline (SCHC 390 & SCHC 499)

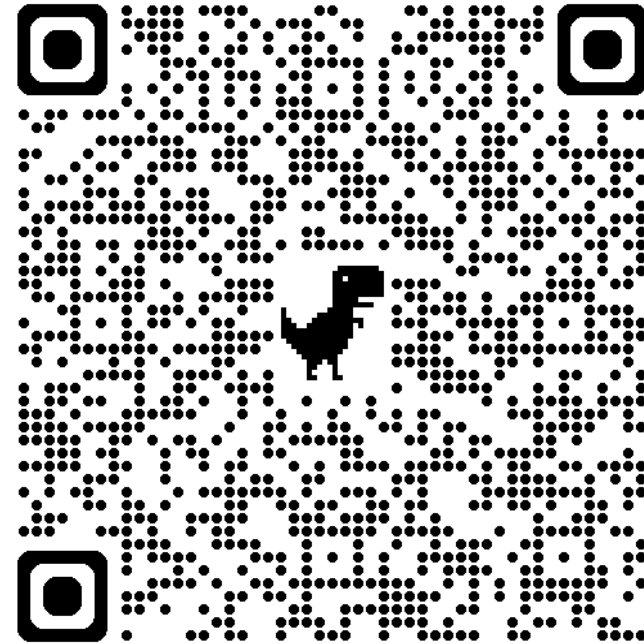
REGISTRATION CHANGES

- With USC's upgrade to Banner 9, the Honors College, it is no longer possible for Honors advisors to register students in courses. Moving forward, Honors students will register themselves for Honors and non-Honors sections of courses during priority registration week at their **assigned ticket time**.
- Course registration will no longer take place during advising appointments. As a result, those appointments will no longer be scheduled by entry year, and students will have the flexibility to schedule their advising appointment any time between mid-September and priority registration week.
- Permission to register for Honors sections of courses (**e.g. H01**) will be granted to all Honors students in Self-Service Carolina before priority registration week.
