Announcements

- Holly Gentry was introduced. She is working with Angelina Sylvain on the System's Optimization Task Force and Strengthening Ambitions initiative.
- 3MT is being held on November 8th and 29 entries. Need to see how we can increase participation.
- Searching for the Director of Professional Development. Currently, we have 17 applicants. Would like to get this position filled quickly.
- Working on the position description for the Assistant Dean of Information Technology. We need to have somebody on board to work with the strengthening admissions initiative.
- We are working to fill Murray Mitchell's position. One concession that may be made is to create 2 half-time positions. Some concerns and discussion were:
 - Funding 2 positions vs 1 cost.
 - Do we have any halftime deans/associate deans in your colleges?
 - Working 50% Graduate School and 50% still in their college. Complicating factors for the home unit.
 - It would be difficult having 2 different people in the role. Feels like it is not cohesive, and communication will be difficult. Communication between the two may be difficult if they have a part-time position in another college that does not give them time to communicate.
 - Half time job would ultimately become a full-time job.

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• After much discussion, the AAGDC did not feel that this might have some challenges and concerns.

Systems Optimization Task Force update

- Three campus demonstrations of the admissions system under consideration. These demos will be recorded for those that are not able to attend.
 - November 4th, 10-11:30 a.m. Element 451. This is the only software vendor system that is not currently on our campus or used by anyone on our campus.
 - November 6th, 2-3:30 pm Liaison CAS Target X. Has 2 different platforms, one for the application, one for the main enrollment management process.
 - November 7th, 10-11:30 a.m. Slate. Uses a 3rd party provider that provides slate service.
 - November 12th, 1-2:00 p.m. Community Forum discussion and feedback regarding the 3 systems.
 - Vendor finalists will be selected by the Systems Optimization Task Force at the end of October.

- Will be looking at Admission Requirement at the Graduate Director's meeting on Thursday, October 31st to discuss the following items:
